- 1. I will always maintain the utmost respect for the game.
- 2. I will conduct myself honorably at all times and maintain the dignity of my position.
- 3. I will always honor an assignment or any other contractual obligation.
- 4. I am responsible for the safety of the players during a game.
- 5. I will not tolerate nor allow abusive behavior or language.
- 6. I pledge to know the rules and regulations of the games and divisions to which I am assigned.
- 7. I promise to enforce the rules fairly.
- 8. I will show respect for other referees, coaches and players and never promote criticism of them.
- 9. I promise to handle players, coaches and parents/spectators effectively by being courteous and considerate without sacrificing fairness. I will manage disputes with coaches and players calmly and respectfully.
- 10. I understand I am a teacher of the game and will take advantage of teachable moments with players to help them understand rules and regulations.
- 11. I will not make statements about any game except to clarify an interpretation of rules.
- 12. I will not discriminate against nor take any undo advantage of any individual group on the basis of race, color, religion, sex or national origin.
